Norwich City Centre Business Improvement District (BID) Ballot

DECLARATION OF RESULT

The result of the BID ballot held on 30 July 2012 was as follows:

The total number of votes cast in the ballot excluding any votes given on ballot papers rejected:	203
The total number of votes cast in favour of the BID proposal:	161 (79%)
The aggregate rateable value of each hereditament in respect of which a person voted in the ballot:	£25,764,000
The aggregate rateable value of each hereditament in respect of which persons voting in the ballot have voted in favour of the proposal:	£23,447,250 (91%)

I hereby declare that the Norwich City Centre Business Improvement District proposal is approved as a majority of the business ratepayers in the BID area who voted in a ballot, both by aggregate rateable value and number voting, voted in favour of the proposal.
